Brigholme and Haworth win Ontario Ministry of Health Project

TORONTO, Ontario, Canada - July 19, 2005 - The McGuinty government has moved forward with the creation of Local Health Integration Networks (LHINs) – 14 local organizations that will be responsible for planning, integrating and funding local health services to make it easier for patients to access the care they need.

Brigholme and Haworth have been awarded the contract to furnish all 14 locations. Brigholme will oversee and manage the delivery and installation across Ontario.

"We are creating LHINs because local health services are best planned at the local level, by people familiar with the needs of a community," Health and Long-Term Care Minister, George Smitherman said. "You can't micromanage a \$33 billion health care system from an office in Toronto. We need local expertise from right across Ontario to help plan and co-ordinate the health care services that are right for people in different communities."
